



Security Requirements for COVID-19

These rules are provided by the CDC, DOH and OSHA, they will be posted visibly at each location during outdoor services and in the temple.

1. Authorized access to the interior location of the church should be primarily through the front door. Other access points will be kept closed.
2. All employees, members and visitors who attend must wear face masks before, during and after the service (whether inside or outside the church).
3. There can be no direct physical contact between servers, members, or visitors. Anything to consume cannot be presented to members or visitors in a communal bowl or plate.
4. During outdoor service, you can only leave the vehicle in an emergency or if you must use the bathroom other than that, being out of the vehicle during service is not allowed.



5. Access to the restrooms will be allowed if access is controlled and limited to no more than 2 people at a time. People waiting to use the bathroom must keep at least 6 feet of distance between each person.
6. The church will not provide any type of drink (water) or food. You can bring them from home, but it must be consumed inside the vehicle.
7. Soap and water will be provided for frequent hand washing. Alcohol based hand sanitizers with more than 60% ethanol, or 70% isopropanol will be provided as well but this is not a replacement for hand washing. (Please wash your hands for 20 seconds).
8. Disinfectants will be available to all employees, members, and visitors.
9. All members and visitors must meet physical clearance requirements and have six feet of space between seats, congregation benches, or have physical barriers between them.
10. Garbage cans will be placed all over the facility (indoor and outdoor).



Members and visitors will be asked to take their temperature before attending a service. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 F will not be allowed to attend the service.

Anyone with a household member who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or any symptoms of COVID-19 (including a fever above 100.4 F) will NOT be allowed to attend the service.

Unfortunately we have to inform you that when the temple reopens, the person who is not willing to submit to the rules established by the CDC and Canaan Christian Church will have to be asked to leave the building /temple until such a person is willing to follow the requirements established by Montgomery County.

Each person will be attending at their own risk, and will not be able to sue the Canaan Christian Church Defenders of the Faith in the event that such a person is contaminated by Covid19. That is, the person is not obligated by the organization to attend, he does so on his own initiative and desire.
